

KATC Update – 2 June 2020

The LTA has recently updated its guidance as follows below. Please continue to strictly follow social distancing and the rules we as a committee have previously outlined for entering and leaving the courts. Your continued support in being vigilant in our cleaning and sanitising is most appreciated and will ensure that everyone stays safe.


NEW If you are happy to play doubles with those from other households you can but please be aware of social distancing requirements and have a discussion beforehand about who gets the middle balls to allow you to remain 2 metres apart. If you don't feel that this is possible, please continue to play singles.

NEW Players do not now have to use their own clearly marked tennis balls but this is still advised however, if you choose to use shared balls then extra care must be taken to ensure you do not touch your face during play, and you should clean your hands before play and immediately after finishing (use alcohol gel if required).

Players should still avoid using their hands to pick up tennis balls from other courts, where possible use your racquet or foot to return them.

Finally, the government has advised that should anyone have symptoms of COVID-19 following playing at the venue that they should go to the government's 'Test and Trace' section of their website to limit the spread of infection.
